VENTURA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT Memorandum of Understanding Between Ventura Unified School District And Ventura Unified Education Association March 24, 2021

This Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") between the Ventura Unified School District ("District") and the Ventura Unified Education Association ("VUEA") (referred to collectively as "the Parties") involves the return to full-time In-Person instruction, with an added Distance learning component.

The Parties recognize the need to customize the In-Person instructional model for schools and Distance Learning for Elementary during the COVID-19 Pandemic to return to in-person to the greatest extent possible and promote student emotional well-being, while adhering to the health and safety orders and guidelines of our federal, state and county public health agencies. To that end, it is in the mutual interest of both Parties to establish instructional delivery that maximizes in-person instruction. Student and staff safety remain paramount in our planning processes and goals.

It is in the mutual interest of the Parties to abide by the recommendations of public health officials to prevent illness and further spread of the virus based on the best available public health data at this time, best practices, and the practical realities of managing school operations. Pursuant to Article 4 (Continuance of Work) in the current Collective Bargaining Agreement ("CBA"), the District and VUEA recognize the duty and obligation of all parties to comply with the current CBA including for unit member discipline, the defined scope of work and as a standard for evaluations for the 2020-2021 school year. All MOUs negotiated to address the Covid-19 pandemic remain in full force and effect, except where they are inconsistent with this MOU.

As of April 1, 2021, the following terms will be in effect:

- 1. On April 1, 2021, an online secondary orientation will take place. Secondary educators will return in person to site classrooms in order to host Zoom orientations for students returning to school using the current Distance-Learning schedule.
 - a. Secondary members will be provided a minimum of three (3) hours in the afternoon on April 1, 2021 to prepare their classrooms for the return of students on Monday, April 12, 2021.
 - b. Elementary teachers will not be required to teach target groups in the afternoon on April 1, 2021 to provide additional time to prep classrooms for the return of students on Monday, April 12, 2021.
- 2. Ventura Unified School District shall follow the Center for Disease Control/California Department of Public Health/Ventura County Public Health's current and on-going guidance on social distancing between students, members, and all adults.
- 3. Schedules:
 - a. Secondary will adhere to a phase-in in-person approach as described below.
 - i. Secondary "Two (2) Week Phase-In In-Person Schedule" will begin April 12th through April 23, 2021.
 - ii. Secondary "Full-Return In-Person Schedule" will begin April 26, 2021 through the end of the school year.
 - iii. All schedules are attached below.
 - b. Elementary will adhere to the in-person approach.
 - i. The "Elementary Full-Time In-Person Schedule" will begin April 12, 2021 through the end of the school year for students who selected in-person learning.

- ii. The "Elementary Distance Learning Schedule" will begin April 12, 2021 through the end of the school year for students who selected distance-learning.
- iii. All schedules are attached below.

4. Stipends

- a. Elementary and EIC In-Person members (including Counselors, Nurses, SLPs, Teachers, Teacher-Librarians) shall be given a stipend of six hundred dollars total (\$600) per full month worked inperson, prorated to FTE, for the work of Hybrid and In-Person education for the five (5) months they have been working in-person at school sites. Elementary or EIC staff returning on April 12, 2021 from Distance to In-Person teaching would be eligible to receive six hundred dollars (\$600) per month for a maximum of two (2) months, prorated to FTE.
- b. Elementary and EIC Distance-Learning members (including Teachers) shall be given a one-time stipend of six hundred dollars (\$600) total, prorated to FTE, for the increased work of larger class sizes, increased parent communication, developing Canvas and other platforms, etc.
- c. Secondary members (including Counselors, Nurses, SLPs, Teachers, Teacher-Librarians) shall be given a stipend of five hundred dollars total (\$500) a month for two months, prorated to FTE, for the work of returning in-person while also supporting the off-day and distance-only students.
- d. Dual-Modality stipend. Teachers as of April 12, 2021, with both in person and distance learning rosters, teaching concurrently shall receive five hundred dollars (\$500) a month for two (2) months, prorated to FTE.
- e. Stipends shall be issued based on teachers' assignment on April 12, 2021. The District shall reassess employees who have assignment changes after April 12, 2021. Stipend(s) shall be reevaluated based on number of days in either assignment. Stipends are paid each month.
- 5. Ventura Unified School District and Ventura Unified Education Association agree to pay eighty dollars per hour (\$80/hour) for the 2021 Summer School and 2021 Extended School Year programs.

The parties share joint interests in keeping communication open and working collaboratively for the benefit of students, staff, parents, and the District community as events continue to unfold during the pandemic.

- 1) This MOU shall terminate no later than June 11, 2021, unless both parties mutually agree upon an extension, excluding summer program pay rates which terminate no later August 18, 2021.
- 2) The provisions of this MOU shall not be modified and/or changed unless both parties mutually agree.
- 3) This MOU shall not be precedent setting nor form any basis for a past practice.
